Delphi Adventure Centre provides up to 20 daily land and water activities including kayaking on Killary Fjord (on Ireland's Blueway), surfing at Cross Beach, Coasteering at Old Head and zip-lining in the 300 acre Delphi forest!

Welcome

Aasleagh Lodge is a beautifully restored, 19th century Victorian Country House in Leenane, Connemara, Co. Galway, right on Ireland's Wild Atlantic Way. It is idyllically situated beside Aasleagh Falls and overlooking the stunning Killary Fjord.

Set in 36 acres of mature woodlands, the 9 bedroom lodge is located right on The Western Way route. It boasts breathtaking views of Killary Harbour and the surrounding mountains, and a short walk through the grounds will bring you to the majestic Aasleagh Falls, an internationally famous waterfall on the Erriff River.

Aasleagh Lodge is one of the Great Fishing Houses of Ireland and has a unique location beside one of the finest spate rivers in Ireland. It also has 2 adjacent self-catering cottages on the grounds, all a perfect base for exploring the sights of Connemara and the south Mayo region.

The lodge, once part of the estate of the Marquis of Sligo, is now managed by Delphi Resort.



Accommodation

Aasleagh Lodge has 9 spacious bedrooms which have been restored and offer traditional luxury and modern furnishings. With its quiet surroundings and luxurious rooms, you are assured of a good night's sleep in comfort and tranquillity.

Aasleagh Cottages are also situated on the grounds - two spacious, self-catering cottages which boast unrivalled views of Killary Fjord and the surrounding mountains. They are each equipped with timber fires, two ensuite bedrooms, a lounge, a kitchen, a large dining area, a garden and a patio with BBQ facilities.
